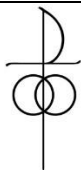


## Parish Journey to Jerusalem

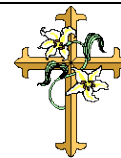

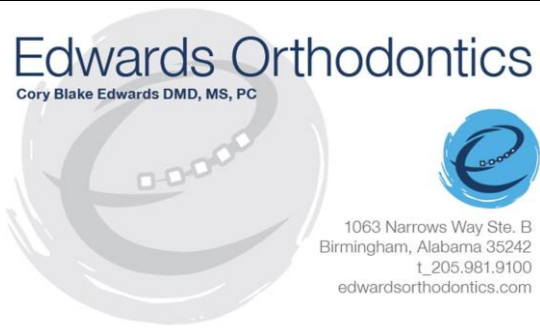
