Dear Fellow Parishioners,

I am very excited to begin serving our parish as the Director of Children, Youth, and Family Ministry. 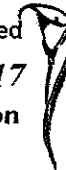

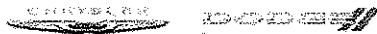
