

To ensure parish family input in the Middle School Program, the Youth Minister will be part of the Parish Youth Advisory Committee.

Duties and Responsibilities:

The Middle School Youth Program is referred to as B.L.A.S.T. (Believing, Living and Sharing the Truth) and is for **grades 6 - 8**. The responsibilities of the Youth Minister to the BLAST Program may include, but are not limited to:

- Planning, organizing, and coordinating the BLAST Youth program
- Scheduling monthly events including opportunities for:
 - Service experiences for youth, including the Greene County Mission Program
 - Retreats and Prayer experiences

To ensure parish family input in the High School Programs, the Youth Minister will be part of the Parish Youth Advisory Committee.

Duties and Responsibilities:

The High School Religious Education program is referred to as RAP (Reflection and Praise) and is for **grades 10-12**. The High School Youth Ministry Program is referred to as JCREW (Jesus Crew) and is for all students from **grade 9-12**. The responsibilities of the Youth Minister to these programs may include, but are not limited to:

- Planning, organizing, and coordinating the RAP Program (grades 10-12) which meets on Sunday mornings from 9 – 10:15 A.M.
- Recruiting adult volunteers

JCREW

 - Retreats and Prayer experiences
 - Fun-filled community building times
 - Opportunities for speakers, discussion and sharing
- Encouraging attendance at Retreats, Diocesan Programs and National Gatherings (NCYC).
- Recruiting adult volunteers.
- Communicating regularly with parents and youth
- Developing and maintaining a program budget
- Participating in the Confirmation program (grade 9)
- Coordinating Youth Masses
- Providing support for the Parish Boy Scout Program

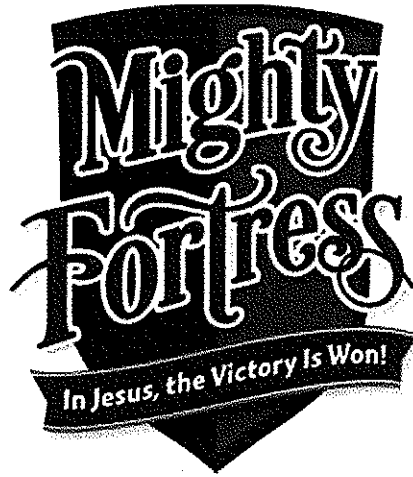

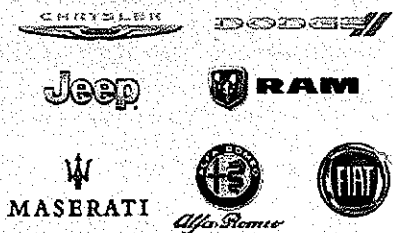
