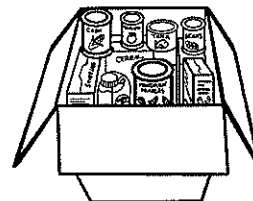
Saint Mark the Evangelist Parish has, from its beginning, supported the Center of Concern in Greene County, Alabama.
