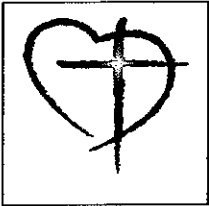

Our Blessing Cup

The chalice that we use for our weekend Masses, donated by the Sal and Paula Marino, has been used at the Parish since the dedication of the Church Sanctuary in 2003. Prior the chalice was used by Saint Pope John Paul II for a Mass in his private chapel in the Vatican. Since he has been declared an official saint of the Church, the chalice is considered a Relic.

Unfortunately because of the way the base was constructed, over time it has begun to hold water when washed. The water sometimes leaks or drips from the bottom of the chalice. The Liturgy Committee discussed the possibility of repairing the chalice; however, because the chalice is now considered a relic, we were advised not to initiate repairs since the base would have to be replaced. The Committee considered the possibility of purchasing a new chalice; but due to the expense the decision was made to continue using the chalice until the condition worsened.

Recently, Bishop David Foley, a member of our parish and a resident at Somerby Retirement Community, graciously gave for my personal use his chalice given to him when he was ordained in 1956. It is a beautiful chalice and because of the design, it has worn well with age and will never leak or tarnish. In Bishop Foley's honor, the Liturgy Committee agrees that it would be a blessing for our Parish to use the chalice for our weekend Masses. We will start using the chalice as the Lenten Season begins on Ash Wednesday. It is a personal honor to celebrate Mass with Bishop Foley's chalice, especially mindful of his care and ministry establishing Saint Mark Parish in 1999 and his continued support over the years.

The current chalice will be on display in the sanctuary for a few weeks and will soon be used as part of a new Vocation Awareness Program we will initiate for our parish. The chalice, which is a wonderful symbol of the Vocation Sacraments and the Eucharist, will be presented to a select family to be placed in a location of honor in their home for a period of one week. During that time, the family will be encouraged to pray for vocations to the priesthood, religious life and lay leaders in the Church. In addition, the members of the family will be invited to pray for themselves as they discern and discover anew God's call in their life and more readily echo Mary's "yes" to God as first disciple.

The Chalice Vocation Program is not a new idea, but rather a National Vocation Awareness Program that many parishes across the United States are using to promote a culture of vocations that provides the necessary support for others to hear and respond to God's call in their lives. We are grateful to Bishop Foley for making the opportunity possible at Saint Mark.

We will begin the Program in August with the start of a new PSR year. I will let you know more how you and your family can participate if you are interested. Let us continue growing in faith drawing strength from the Eucharist and becoming more generous and courageous in our vocations.

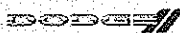
